No app, plugin or installation

In a nutshell, scrawlar is a slimmed down version of Google Drive where students can type, edit and share docs with each other and the teacher. It works in the browser on computers, tablets and phones.



# Simplicity

- Like twiducate or bitstrips, teachers sign up and add students to the class.
- Scrawlar does not ask for any student details like an email address.

From here students can write, edit, collaborate and share work with each other as well as yourself. scawlar works on all tablets, phones and computers and provides a means for printing from these devices through a computer. However, printing is no longer necessary! Students can submit work within scawlar!
